
The Everyday Reality ... maybe somewhat different



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- 1. Our Data Hub pipeline focussed on selected, core data requirements
- 2. Additional data feeds and data rules at any time
- 3. Configure Data Services: Merging people into families and any other groups / associations

 Create automatic 'As-Is' Profiling, Alerts and Predictive Analysis

 Establish a full chronology of events & outcomes
- 4. Profiling & Scoring rules to identify different target cohorts for different teams
- 5. Creating as many Portals and outbound feeds to share data across all teams & agencies






Liverpool Families Programme – National Troubled Families Programme



- Between April 2015 and March 2020, Liverpool has been allocated 6760 families by the Ministry for Housing, Communities and Local Government to identify, engage with under a key worker approach and monitor for significant & sustained progress (2nd Phase)
- To be eligible for the programme, families with at least one child or young person under the age of 18 at the point of identification must meet at least two of the following criteria:
 - Parents and children Involved in crime or ASB;
 - Children not attending school;
 - 3. Children who need help;
 - 4. Adult worklessness and children at risk of worklessness;
 - 5. Families affected by domestic abuse;
 - 6. Parents and children with health problems.
- The Liverpool Families Programme Outcomes Plan defines the cities strategic approach to working with complex families and outlines how significant and sustained progress is measured
- Since April 2018, Liverpool has had 'Earned Autonomy' status to accelerate transformation
- From September 2019, the National Troubled Families Programme has been extended by a further 12 months to March 2021.

ICT Solution Key Requirements



- Automated Family matching
- Handle large volumes of data
- An integrated partnership data system to profile Liverpool families to ascertain if they meet criteria as outlined in the Liverpool Families Programme Outcomes Plan
- Ability to track and monitor families for 'payment by results' outcomes
- Evaluate effectiveness of funded initiatives and projects
- Provide MHCLG with performance information via the National Impact Study (NIS) and Family Progress Data (FPD)
- Improve partnership working and lives of residents
- Longevity...

- Report back to Families Strategic Group








Sentinel Solution Overview – Just what we needed!

A Multi-Layered approach to Data Integration and Data Sharing



Support online services, customer interactions & partner collaboration

Share with any internal and external teams & partners via tailored portals.

Monitor data and trigger alerts (pro-active intervention).

Sharing back to source systems to make common use of the most complete and most trusted data.

The collected data is Validated, Cleansed & merged into a new Single View of a person.

(The Baseline Solution.)

Then match People to any Groups

We then Score (profile) to identify any number of target cohorts.

Collect any information available to you, from any System, from any DB Type and from any Partner Agency












Liverpool Families Programme Results





Deprivation within Liverpool by Lower Super Output Area (LSOA), where an IMD score of 1 indicates the most deprived 10% of LSOAs nationally.




Families within Liverpool who are known to the Troubled Families Programme and meet the TF criteria for crime.





Intelligence Key For Strategic decisions...

Predictive Analysis - Liverpool Family Complexity





- Stop checked in a gang after an assault
- Criminal activity started in early teenage years
- Older siblings also have history of criminal activity
- School attendance dropping year on year
- Multiple schools
- Attended PRU
- Previous school interventions
- SEN statements
- All reside in Housing Association properties
- High level of benefit claims
- Single adult families
- Criminal activity has escalated latest police intelligence
- Sibling attendance remains high


How the Project is Transforming Services – The Future 🖗
