
The Programme

- LGA is funded by the Cabinet Office National Cyber Security Programme (NCSP). The programme is now in the final year of the initial three-year agreement.
- So far, highlights include:
 - Delivery of a Cyber Security Stocktake which 100% of councils completed (year 1)
 - Delivery of a Self-assessment tool which 54% of councils completed (year 2).
 - Support in the response and recovery of Redcar and Cleveland Council (year 2).
 - Direct support to over 90% of English Councils to improve cyber via c£3.1M of direct targeted grants (years 1&2).




Councils Reached







Local Covernment Local Government interface






Parts of the system with which LG has varying degrees of interest or responsibility

NCSC Threat Report

- June 2020 NCSC report on threats in light of COVID-19 highlighted:
 - Phishing is responsible for the vast majority of cyber-attacks against public sector organisations
 - Some LAs have set up new or adapted existing websites, portals or applications as part of their COVID-19 response. It is a realistic possibility that these will be targeted by criminals.



FY20/21 SOW







- The development of comprehensive cyber standards with an associated maturity framework.
- The development of a corresponding **assessment tool** which greatly improves on the 2019 tool.
- Scaling up the trial of penetration testing to support a greater percentage of councils.
- The purchasing of a **cyber awareness raising package** for local government saving up to £1.5M per annum.
- The development of systematic peer support for pre-incident and post-incident.
- A better **understanding the comprehensive attack picture** for local authorities.
- A review of incident management practices.
